

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 conducted public hearings on August 21, 2018 and August 28, 2018 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 6.16 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$2,637,104.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$2,789,145.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$2,881,328.

The COMMISSIONERS of Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 4, 2018 at PORTER FIRE STATION 121, 23550 LOOP 494, PORTER, TX 77365 at 12:00 PM.

The COMMISSIONERS of Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of making capital improvements and acquisitions and to maintain fire suppression personnel necessary to meet current and projected fire and rescue call volume at the level of

service expected by the District's residents..
